Kodiak's Marine Infrastructure

- **Pier I - 204' x 28'**
- **Pier II - 925' x 64'**
- **Pier III - 490' x 64'**
- **Two Harbors - 650 stalls**
- **Tidal Grid - 232'**
- **Gravel Grid - 125'**
- **2 General Purpose Docks**
- **Within 2 years a 600 ton travel lift**



Effect on Kodiak Economy

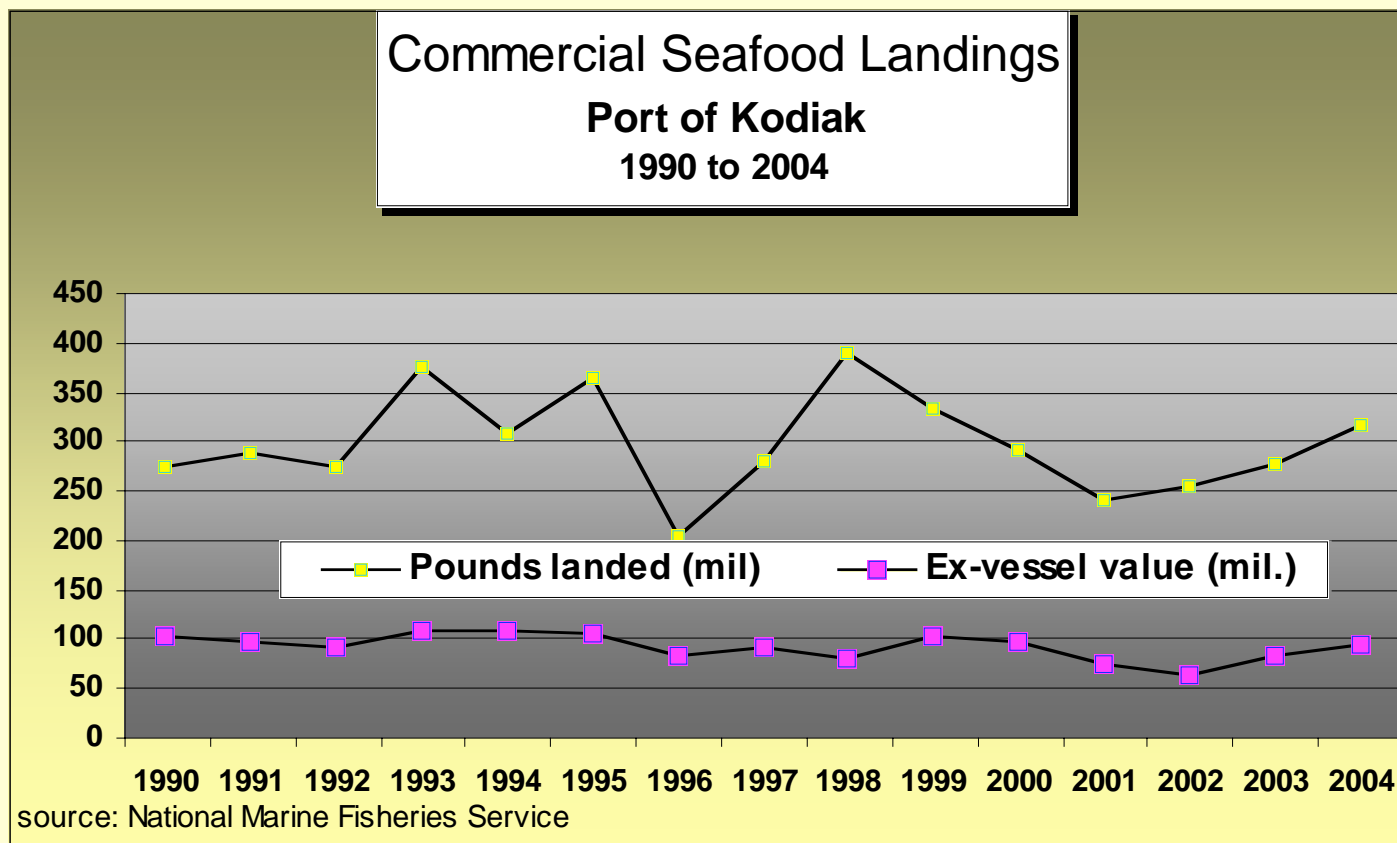
**2005 Landings - 366.3 million pounds with a
wholesale value of \$95.2 million**

- a. Halibut - 26%**
- b. Salmon - 19%**
- c. Pacific Cod - 18%**
- d. Pollock - 15%**
- e. Sablefish - 8%**

Effect on Kodiak Economy

- **1,158 commercial fishing permits held by area residents**
- **650 employed in harvesting sector**
- **1,368 employed in processing plants (\$54 million payroll)**

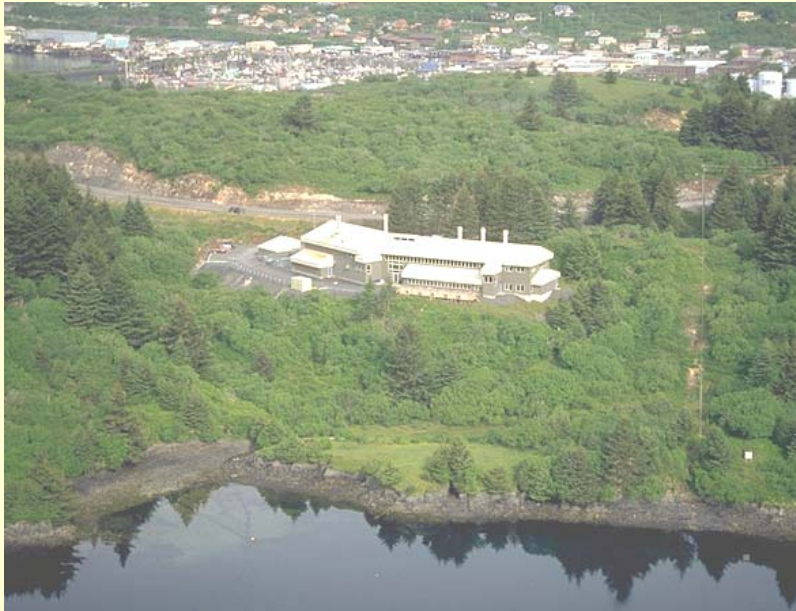
