PRE-CONFERENCE Adventures



DOG SLED RIDE Every half hour • \$75 • Sign up by 5pm March 26
Take a 5-mile/30-minute ride with local mushers on trails just outside Nome. Visit the kennel, learn how dogs are trained for racing, meet former Iditarod dogs, and take photos with your favorite dogs. **What to bring:** Hats, gloves, warm boots, snowpants, jackets. Sitting on a sled can be cold!



NOME DAY TOUR 2:30-5pm • \$75
Spend the afternoon with tour guide extraordinaire and mayor of Nome, Richard Beneville, for an entertaining, educational, insightful and honest experience. The story of Nome celebrates a vibrant Native culture living in the far North and adapting to jolting changes; the Gold Rush; and a strategic military presence. You will travel in the Nome Discovery Tour van. **Dress for a winter drive.**



SNOWSHOE OUTING 3-5pm • \$30
Stretch your legs after the journey to Nome by stepping into a pair of snowshoes and walking through a wintery wonderland. **What to bring:** Breathable layers, gloves/mittens, warm boots, hat, gater (gear you'll be comfortable in while active no matter the temps), and daypack for extra layer/gear, water, snacks.



MUSKOX TOUR 1:30-3pm • \$20
Join Claudia Ihl, NWC biology professor, for a drive on Nome's road system to view muskox herds in the area. **Dress for a winter drive. *NOTE:** If pre-tour reconnaissance indicates no muskox are within viewing distance of the road, we will substitute a FREE slide presentation, "The Year of the Muskox."



MIDNITE SUN REINDEER RANCH TOUR 3-5 pm • \$40
Take a 26-mile round-trip scenic drive by van along the Kougarok Road to the Midnight Sun Reindeer Ranch, owned and operated by the Davis family. See a reindeer up close and learn about being a modern-day reindeer entrepreneur. **What to bring:** Hats, gloves/mittens, warm boots, snowpants, jackets for standing outside in the snow and wind for 1 hour, sunglasses, camera.



TRADITIONAL CRAFTING WORKSHOP 1:30-3pm • \$20
Make a key chain of reindeer and salmon leather, and a pair of earrings and necklace of reindeer antler or shin bone with Jackie Hrabok-Leppäjärvi, NWC traditional crafts instructor. **What to bring:** Clothes you don't mind getting dirty and a hair elastic if you have long hair. Apron, safety equipment provided.
